Our Lady of Sorrows
The Church dedicates the month of September to Our Lady of Sorrows. The Devotion of Our Lady of Sorrows is a devotion given to us by St. Bridget of Sweden in the 14th century. In this Devotion, we are invited to console the Sorrowful Heart of Mary and to unite our suffering to hers, and, by doing so, receive beautiful graces of consolation & strength. Let us take refuge in the comforting Heart of our Mother Mary. She understands our sufferings from the depth of her own experience and she wants to fill our pained hearts with hope in her Son. The Seven Sorrows of Mary are: (1) The Prophecy of Simeon (2) The Flight into Egypt (3) The Loss of Jesus for Three Days (4) The Meeting of Jesus Carrying His Cross (5) The Crucifixion of Jesus (6) Jesus Taken Down from the Cross (7) Jesus Laid in the Tomb.
