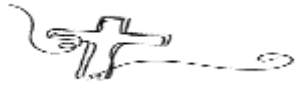

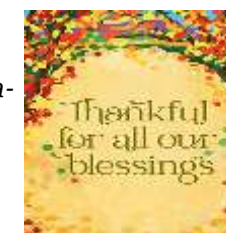

taught by Mark Postma, an instructor with the
Catholic Biblical School of Michigan. Mark
also holds a Master's degree in theology from
Franciscan University.

The lectures will be from 6:15-7:30 central time
Thursday evenings from mid September thru
mid-May. We will study the historical books of
the Old Testament, Genesis to 2 Maccabees,
where we address who God is, who we are, why
bad things happen, how we handle the hard
passages in the Old Testament, and explore
God's steadfast love for us. The classes will be
live streamed to us in Serio Hall. There is a
suggested donation for the course, but no one
is turned away—all we ask is that you ask the
